Know the difference

ASSISTED LIVING

Housing, meals, supervision, medication help and assistance with daily activities. It is not ordinarily the intensive medical care of a nursing home.

HOSPICE CARE

A medical service for people with a terminal illness. The care team usually visits wherever the patient lives—home, assisted living, nursing facility or hospital.

HOSPICE HOUSE

A dedicated residential setting for hospice patients who need inpatient symptom management or prefer a hospice residence when space and eligibility permit.

How to use this guide

- Start with the city or area that works for the family.
- Call several organizations; services, prices, eligibility and openings differ.
- Use the question checklists near the end of the guide during tours and phone calls.
- Check state licensing and Medicare information before making a final choice.

HOSPICE CARE

Hospice is usually a service rather than a place. The team may care for a patient in a private home, assisted-living community, nursing home, hospital or dedicated hospice residence.

REMEMBER: A family can usually choose a hospice agency even when the patient already lives in an assisted-living or long-term-care community, but the agency may need a contract with that community.

QUESTIONS TO ASK BEFORE CHOOSING

Assisted living

- What is the monthly base charge, and which services are billed separately?
- How are additional care-level and medication-management fees calculated?
- How many staff members are present overnight and on weekends?
- Is a registered nurse physically present, and during which hours?
- Is memory care available if needs increase?
- Does the community participate in a Medicaid waiver program?
- What medical or behavioral conditions could require a resident to move?
- May a resident remain in the community while receiving hospice care?

Hospice

- Are nurses available for in-person visits after hours?
- Can the agency provide continuous home care during a crisis?
- Does it contract with the preferred assisted-living or nursing facility?
- What inpatient hospice and caregiver-respite arrangements are available?
- How quickly are medications and medical equipment delivered?
- Are veterans' services and family bereavement support available?

VERIFY BEFORE YOU DECIDE

- Confirm the organization's current license or Medicare certification.
- Ask for a complete written fee schedule and sample residency or service agreement.
- Tour in person when possible—including during an evening or weekend shift.
- Ask how emergencies, falls, pain crises and changes in care needs are handled.
- Speak with current families when the organization can arrange it.
